

Ocean Exchange Recognizes Members of Selection Review and Pitch Mentoring Teams for Their Dedication and Support

Senior level leaders volunteer time estimated to be worth \$150,000+ to support acceleration of innovative solutions for healthy oceans and the Blue Economy

Fort Lauderdale, Florida, USA, October 13, 2022 – Ocean Exchange, a leader in supporting the acceleration of innovative solutions for healthy oceans and the sustainable Blue Economy, wishes to recognize the dedication and tireless work of the Selection Review and Pitch Mentoring teams for its 2022 Awards Program. These volunteers—all highly respected leaders in business, academia, engineering, and the not-for-profit community—are integral to the process that will culminate in the presentation of the prestigious Neptune, Wallenius Wilhelmsen Orcelle®, Ocean Exchange Transportation Hubs, and Collegiate Awards this month. Ocean Exchange estimates that the value of their time spent in the selection and mentoring processes exceeds \$150,000 USD.

Now in its 11th year, the Ocean Exchange 2022 Awards Program takes place October 23-25 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, USA.

The Selection Review Committee reviewed applications from within the list of 51 semi-finalists from around the world and chose a short list of 24 finalists. The Pitch Mentoring Team is now engaging with the finalists to help them best prepare for their presentations before a curated group of expert delegates at the event. The winner of the Collegiate Award, with prize money of \$10,000 USD, will be announced on Monday, October 24. The Neptune, Orcelle and Transportation Hub Awards, each of which carries a prize of \$100.000 USD, will be conferred on Tuesday, October 25.

"These individuals play a vital role in helping finalists who are competing for what could be life-changing awards that will advance innovation and help shape the future of the Blue Economy. We greatly appreciate their generous contribution of time and dedication in supporting our mission and work. The Ocean Exchange Awards would not exist without their commitment and participation," said Millicent Pitts, Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director of the Ocean Exchange.
